A graduate of Mechanical Engineering from University of Kerala, (TKM College of Engineering, Kollam). He obtained M.Tech. (Turbo machines), and PhD

from IIT Madras. His Training and Research exposure include Nuclear Science and Engineering (1987-1988), Babha Atomic Research centre (1988-1992). Dr Anil Lal has won number of awards like Best researcher of the year award by CERD, Govt. of Kerala (2011), Best teacher award of ISTE-CET chapter for the year (2009 & 2010). He has won national first prize in ISTE-SRMC mathematical competition 2013. He was instrumental in establishing the Centre of Excellence in Computational Fluid Dynamics at College of Engineering Trivandrum. An ardent researcher, he has produced two PhDs and currently supervising 7 students in PhD research. He has to his credit more than 75 publications (including 4 books and 18 International Journal publications). Dr. Anillal has completed 2 RESPOND projects, 2 CERD research projects and 3 consultancy projects (the total worth more than Rs.100 lakh). He has coordinated several workshops and has severed as resource person to a number of short term programs. He is life member in professional bodies like Indian Society for Technical Education, Indian Society for Heat and Mass Transfer, Combustion Institute of India and Aero Society of India.
