Chairman's message

The last two months have been quite eventful as far as Kerala Section is concerned. ISTE Kerala section took the initiative in the long pending issue of implementation of AICTE pay scales to polytechnic college teachers of Kerala. The ISTE national president came down to Trivandrum along with Executive secretary to meet the Hon'ble Chief Minister of Kerala, Shri. Oommen Chandy. The ISTE team could bring to the attention of the CM that Kerala is the only State where AICTE scales are not implemented to polytechnic teachers. In this context it was reinforced by the team that ISTE do not want any dilution of qualification/norms while implementing the scheme. But those who deserve it should not be denied the benefits their counterparts enjoy in other States of the country. Sri. Ommen Chandy ensured that he will consider the matter favourably. ISTE followed this up with a meeting with Finance Ministerof Kerala, Sri. K. M. Mani., who also promised to do the needful. I, on behalf of the Kerala Section thank the Chief Minister and the Finance Minister for their patient hearing and for the assurances. I also thank the president and executive secretary for the personal interest shown in this matter. Let us hope that their efforts are not in vain and the teachers of polytechnic colleges in Kerala will soon be given their due.

The high dropout rates from schools and colleges is a major concern in our country. The policy makers at national level have realised the problem and evolved a number of skill development programmes and courses for the benefit of such dropouts to empower them and also to make them employable. ISTE also plan in a big way to participate in these programmes. A proposal to this effect has been handed over to the Chief Minister of Kerala. Steps also have been taken to have possible tie up with other agencies who are working in this area.

The faculty training and subject up-gradation is a major issue as far as technical education is concerned. At present the number of programmes are very limited and is focussed mostly on government and aided institutions only. The staff training college project of the Kerala Section is primarily intended to provide a permanent platform for such programmes to faculty of all institutions. The chief Minister has shown keen interest in the project. Once ready residential programmes will be conducted throughout the year as per a calendar. I once again request generous contributions from all well wishers for completing the project.



ISTE team Meet with the Chief Minister of Kerala

They have submitted a representation for implementing AICTE pay scale to Polytechnic college teachers of Kerala. They could bring to the notice of CM that this scheme is implemented in all other states except Kerala. The Chief Minister gave an assurance to take positive steps in this issue. ISTE has also extended support for formulating and implementing the schemes for skill development for unemployed youth and school dropouts. Kerala Section submitted a proposal for faculty development programs through ISTE and requested for an one time grant of Rs. 25 lakh for making the staff training college of ISTE at Thrissur operational.
